Try your hand at a bit of cooking. Follow a recipe or use the balance cake idea that we did in school (balance all your ingredients with an egg).

Play a game with someone (you could use the snakes and ladders game within this pack).

Make yourself a clock (there is a pattern in this pack) perhaps you could colour it in first. Now tell the time.


Match your clock to the time on a real clock.

Can you work out what time you get up and go to bed?




Draw a picture using only 2D shapes and label them.
