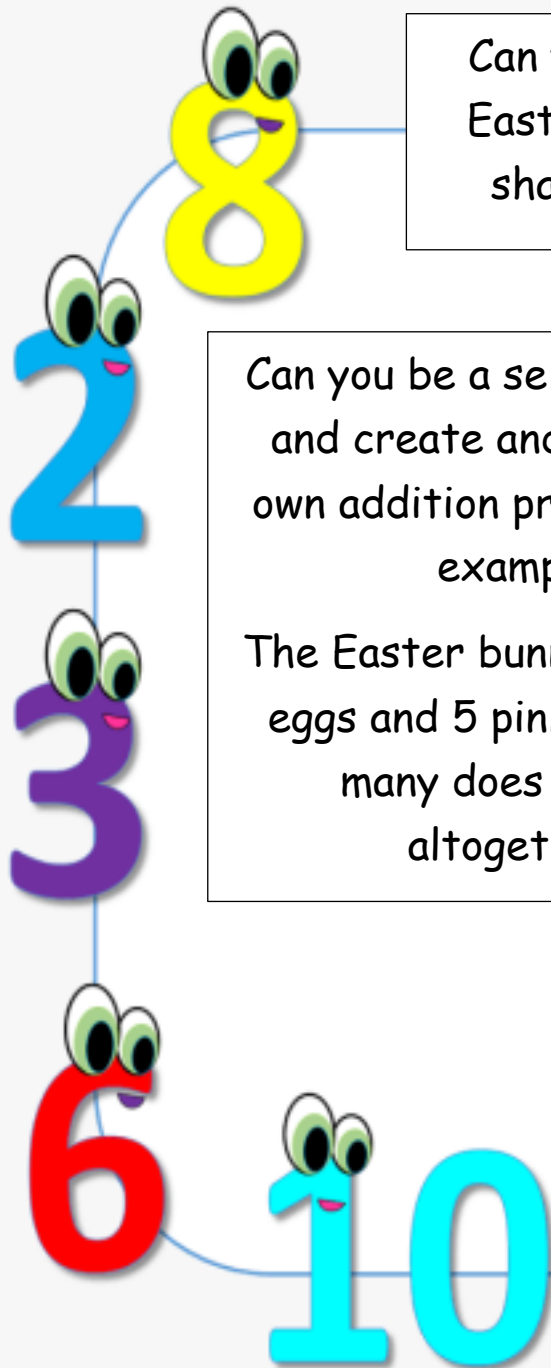

Please use your home Learning Journals to record the tasks. This could be in the form of a photo, a drawing, your child's writing, etc.

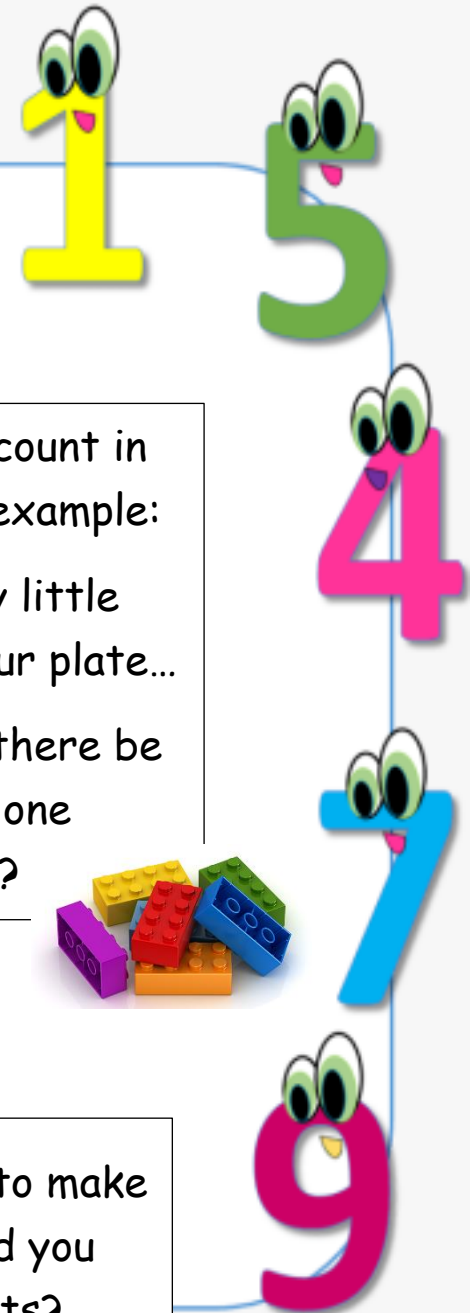

Can you write them independently?



Can you be a self-challenger and create and solve your own addition problems? For example:

The Easter bunny has 3 blue eggs and 5 pink eggs. How many does he have altogether?



Maths

What could you count in your house? For example:
Lego bricks, my little ponies, peas on your plate...

How many would there be if there was one more/less?



Can you create your own maths challenge?

Can you follow a recipe to make something? How could you weigh the ingredients?



Choose some words from the stage 1 words sheet to practise reading. Can you make and read a sentence using them?



How many red words can you read in 1 minute?

Choose a story to read to/with someone. Can you tell them who your favourite character is and why?

How many words can you find in your house? What do they say?



Reading and Writing

Choose some words from the stage 1 words sheet to practise writing. Can you write a sentence using them?

Can you practise writing your letters with a lead in? You can use the sound mat to help you.

Can you write your teacher a postcard or letter telling them something you have done?



Can you create your own reading and writing challenge?

Can you write a story? Who will your character be? What will happen to them? How will it end?

Can you create an Easter picture or model?

Can you make some Easter eggs to hide in an egg hunt around your house?
