Unfair The funding for West Sussex schools is the lowest in the country. Billingshurst Primary School will receive 1.6% increase in funding which isn't enough.

Nothing else We qualify for the basic per-pupil funding only. We get nothing else. We don't qualify for any other funding due to our demographic – our large primary school is not in a deprived area, our children are not under-performing, we are not, in the eyes of the education system in an area of disadvantage.

Done all we can We have done all we can to cut costs. We have reduced the number of teachers. We have reduced the number of Teaching Assistants. We have reduced the number of Leadership Staff. We can't, as a governing body, identify any other areas where we can reduce costs without the very real, very serious threat that your children's education might suffer.

Unhelpful The National Funding Formula that works out our funding doesn't consider that we are a big school whose revenue has been unchanged for the past two years but whose employment and staff costs have risen - National Insurance contributions, pensions, pay increases.
