<p><u>Read all about it</u></p> <p>Complete your own research on refugees from different countries and write a newspaper article for the school newspaper, sharing what you have found out.</p>	<p><u>Poster of welcome</u></p> <p>Create a banner or poster that could be used to display support for refugees.</p>	<p><u>Shine Ya Light</u></p> <p>Listen to Rita Ora's song – Shine Ya Light. What is the message behind the song?</p>
<p><u>Famous People</u></p> <p>There are many well-known names and people who are immigrants to this country. Research one person and write their biography.</p>	<p><u>What would you take?</u></p> <p>If you had to pack your most precious possessions to leave your home and travel to a new, strange country, what would you choose to take and why?</p>	<p><u>Story Writing</u></p> <p>Write your own story that involves a long, dangerous or tiring journey of your choice. Where would you be going? Why? What obstacles might you have to overcome?</p>
<p><u>Food from around the world</u></p> <p>Find and make a dish from somewhere around the world. Share the recipe and perhaps the food with your class mates (please be aware of allergies and ensure food is nut free)</p>	<p><u>Where would you go?</u></p> <p>If you were able to go and live anywhere in the world, where would you go and why? You could present this in the form of a travel brochure.</p>	<p><u>Poetry</u></p> <p>Find a copy of Bliston's poem Refugees on the internet. Read it carefully, forwards and backwards. Write a review of this poem and the powerful message that it has.</p>
