Rainbow Theatre Visit- We'll Meet Again

As part of our topic, we have organised a visit from a company specialising in interactive theatre experiences. The children will see what is described as 'an emotional learning experience' where they will be given the opportunity to understand what it was like for children to be living through the Second World War. Members of the team have used this company before and found them to be excellent, proving an immersive, entertaining and educational experience for the start of our WW2 topic.

The show will start at 1.45pm and run through to the end of the day. It will take place in our KS2 hall on Friday 31st March 2017.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £4.00 to cover the cost of the visit. Although the contribution is voluntary, it should be pointed out that the visit could not take place unless all parents, who are able, are willing to contribute.

Payment will need to be returned by Tuesday 14th March 2017. Where possible, we would ask if parents could use ParentPay to make this contribution. Please ask at the office if you need help or have lost your activation letter.

We appreciate that some families might find it particularly difficult to contribute all or part of the suggested sum. If you are in this position and have need of financial assistance, please apply in confidence to Mrs Brotherton in the school office.

It should also be stressed that if a family were unable to contribute, and the visit were still to proceed, no child within the year group for whom it is intended will be disadvantaged and be left out of the activity.

We are also looking for people who have had direct life experience during the war to come in and speak to small groups of children about their lives during this time. This will be at a later date, but if you know anyone who might be able to come in, please inform your child's class teacher and we will be back in touch.
