

English

We will be basing our writing on the book "Time Travellers Journal". Some of our outcomes will be timelines, stories and letters.

Geography

We will be looking at the extent of the Roman Empire across Europe and the impact of the Empire in the local area.

DT

We will be using pneumatics to power moving parts. The children will be creating inventions using these skills,

RE

This term we will be exploring the main beliefs and comparing Christianity to other religions. (Islam)

PSHCE

We will be exploring how to make people feel welcome.

Science

This term the topic is sound, we will be looking at how sounds are made and how sound travels. This will include logging data on sounds around school. We are also looking at electricity, designing circuits with switches.

French

To link in with our poetry writing our focus is on the seasons and vocabulary associated with them.

Maths

Computing

This term's focus is on internet safety and how to use computing equipment responsibly. We are also looking at using data loggers to collect and present data.

Art

Our focus is on colour and texture and how these affect finished pictures, interpreting the seasons through water colour.

Music

We will be learning and performing a variety of Roman songs, leading us into making our own compositions.

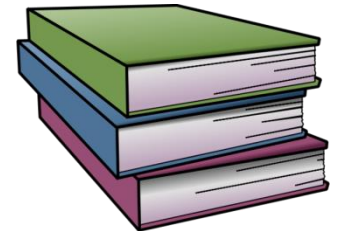
