<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Nature Watch</u></p> <p>Set up an area in your garden or somewhere at home where you can observe animals in their natural environment. Make notes on what you have observed.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Animation</u></p> <p>Using a series of photographs create a time lapse animation of plants growing at home. You could take weekly photographs of a bulb growing and use this in your presentation.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Film</u></p> <p>Film yourself in your garden talking about the animals and plants that you have seen. You could write your own script and present it in the style of David Attenborough.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Plants</u></p> <p>Research plants that are suitable for wildlife and then plant and grow one of these. Does it work? Have you attracted more wildlife to your garden?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Food</u></p> <p>Research, design and produce a menu. What would a robot need to sustain its ultimate performance.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Survey</u></p> <p>Conduct a survey of the animals you find in your garden. Which creature is the most common? Which is the least common? What conditions do the animals like to live in?</p>
