

# Year 4 Homework - Roman Britain Autumn 1st Half Term

Your homework for this term is **YOUR CHOICE!** We have given you **3 shorter activities** and **1 longer activity** to choose from and would like you to complete at least 3 shorter tasks or 1 one long task over the term. We are hoping you will put in a lot of effort for each piece and you will enjoy presenting your homework to the rest of the class and sharing all your hard work. Challenge yourself with a variety of tasks. Dates for handing in homework are flexible. We suggest spending about two weeks on the shorter tasks.

## Shorter Tasks

### 1. Roman Food

Think about the food that was eaten during Roman times. You could create your own menu or even make something and bring it in for us to try!



### 3. Roman Numerals Game

Can you come up with a Roman numerals game that would help to teach other people about the different symbols? You can decide what sort of game it is but you need to be clear on the instructions and rules.

### 2. Dance

We would like you to explore Roman dance. Have a go at choreographing your own dance. This could be done with a friend. You could then film yourself and bring it in for us to watch or even perform live in school!

### 4. Roman Weapons

Design and make your own Roman weapon. Think about the features and how it will work. You might want to write instructions for using it.

### 5. Roman Clothing

We would like you to design a costume for a Roman person. This could be an outfit for a rich Roman lady or even some armour for a Roman soldier.

## Longer Task

### Roman Building Model

Create your own model of a Roman building.

This could be a villa, bath house, amphitheatre or even an aqueduct.

We would like you to research the building and add labels to describe the features and the materials it was made from.

You may want to consider if there are any examples of these buildings that can still be seen in Britain today.
