Read-Write Training Session

Dear Parents

Next term we will be starting our Guided Reading sessions in Reception. These take place four mornings a week (from Monday – Thursday), starting at 9.00am and lasting for about 25 minutes. In order for the programme to run successfully we welcome parent helpers who are able to offer their time on a regular basis to support reading groups. There is a crèche available each morning for younger siblings.

We shall be holding initial training sessions on **Tuesday 9th at 2.30pm** and **Wednesday 10th at 9.00am**. The sessions will be led by Miss Milton and will focus on the initial stage of the Read Write Inc scheme, when the children are reading 'Ditties'. For this reason we would encourage all volunteer helpers to come along to one of the sessions, even if you have previously attended Read-Write training.

There will be a crèche available for the morning session, but not in the afternoon. Please bring toddlers/babies with you to the afternoon session if you need to.

All volunteers are required to obtain a full and current DBS check. Please contact the office for further information.
