www.eric-carle.com/home.html. This site is all about the author of The Very Hungry Caterpillar and shows how he makes the wonderful illustrations for his books

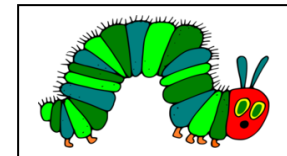
Local places to visit
