<p><u>Weather Watchers</u> Compare the temperature of the Arctic and Antarctic over a period of time. What do you notice about the temperatures? How can you record this?</p> 	<p><u>Fashion Designer</u> Design and make an outfit to keep an explorer warm in freezing conditions.</p>	<p><u>Creative Composers</u> Create a 2 minute piece of music, dance, drama or song based on our topic to present to the class.</p> 	<p><u>Be an author</u> Write a story about an adventure that is set in the Arctic or Antarctic.</p> 
<p><u>Super Scientist</u> Investigate the ways in which people, animals, food and drink keep warm in the polar regions. You can decide how to record your experiment and results.</p>	<p><u>Igloo Designs</u> Can you design a modern igloo? Draw and label your design for both the outside and inside.</p> 	<p><u>Product Design</u> Can you design and make an energy bar for an explorer? What ingredients would you need to include? You can bring in a sample to share (no nuts please). You can write a recipe for your friends to follow.</p>	<p><u>Free Choice</u> You decide on your own activity linked to our topic.
